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#### Rules:

- Eggs will be judged on overall appearance and uniformity only.
- Eggs may be washed but not polished or heavily scrubbed
- Decorated eggs are not permitted
- The Judge has the authority to re-classify an entry based on colouring or disqualify it.
- The Judge's ruling and decisions are final

#### Eggs

1. 1 dozen white eggs, in egg carton
2. 1 dozen brown eggs, in egg carton
3. 6 eggs, any other type or colour in half egg carton
4. Smallest egg, displayed in egg cup
5. Largest egg, displayed in appropriate container
6. Oddest shaped egg, displayed in appropriate container



#### Natural Sweeteners

7. Maple Syrup, 500 ml jar
8. Liquid Honey, 500 ml jar
