Rules:

All entries must be clean and must be the work of the exhibitor. The judges of the Handcraft Division are authorized to discard all soiled, defaced or old works and award the prizes to new up-to-date work. No first prize winning article in previous years may be submitted.

PRIZES **1ST – \$8.00** **2ND – \$6.00** **3RD – \$4.00**
POINTS **1ST – 3 pts** **2ND – 2 pts** **3RD – 1 pt.**

(Specials do not count towards points)

KNITTING:

1. Adult Sweater, 1 colour or more – cardigan
2. Child sweater – 2 colour minimum
3. Baby sweater with Hood (hoodie-style)
4. Afghan Ripple pattern – any size
5. Matching scarf and hat/headband - any size
6. Sweater Child/Adult – Aran or Cable pattern
7. Child/Adult slippers
8. Baby shawl /afghan – any size
9. 2 Cotton dishcloths – different pattern
10. Infinity Scarf
11. Texting Gloves (fingerless gloves/mitts)
12. Afghan – larger than infant
13. Pet Clothing – any size
14. Pet Accessories (pet toy)
15. Baby Infant Set - must include sweater, hat & booties, or mitts
16. Stuffed Toy
17. Character Hat – must resemble an animal, cartoon or caricature - eg. Smurf, dog, cat etc.
18. Any item specific to a holiday season - eg. Christmas, Easter, Halloween etc.
19. Any knitted item not previously mentioned
20. Headband/hair accessory
21. Doll Clothing
22. Home décor item
23. Socks, Adult or Child-sized
24. Cushion - Cable pattern and stuffed

Knitting Champion:

The exhibitor receiving the most points in sections 1 to 24 will be declared Knitting Champion and will be invited to the Awards Presentation. An award of \$50 will be awarded to the Champion. Winner is eligible once every 2 years.

CROCHETING:

25. One 6" Granny Square – minimum 2 colours
26. 2 Placemats – matching
27. Granny square garment
28. Adult slippers
29. 2 Cotton dishcloths – different patterns
30. Afghan using crocheted squares – any size
31. Texting gloves/mittens (fingerless)
32. Mile – a – Minute Afghan – any size
33. Pet Clothing – any size
34. Pet Accessories
35. Baby Jacket and Hat (hoodie-style)
36. Baby Infant set – must include sweater and hat
37. Infinity Scarf
38. Stuffed Toy
39. Character Hat – must resemble an animal, cartoon or caricature – eg. Smurf, dog, cat etc.
40. Any item specific to a holiday season – eg. Christmas, Easter, Halloween etc.
41. Recycled item – old item restored using yarn and crocheting (before & after pictures required)
42. Any crocheted item not previously mentioned
43. Child/baby Slippers
44. Baby Afghan
45. Adult/Child Sweater
46. Matching scarf and hat/mittens –any size
47. Granny Square Pillow
48. Home décor item

Crocheting Champion:

The exhibitor receiving the most points in sections 25 to 50 will be declared Crocheting Champion and will be invited to the Awards Presentation . The Champion will be awarded \$50. Winner is eligible once every 2 years.

SEWING:

49. Child PJ's –onesie or 2 piece or nightgown style
50. Dress – girl's
51. Grocery bag
52. Pet Clothing – any size
53. Pet Accessory
54. Pot-holders/oven gloves
55. Doll clothing
56. Stuffed Toy
57. Child's jacket (hoodie)

58. Any item specific to a holiday season – eg. Christmas,
59. Easter, Halloween
60. Fleece hat and scarf
61. Bib apron
62. Jazzed up hoodie, use sewing techniques (no fabric paint)
63. Fleece comforter – with tied edges
64. Baby sleep sack.
65. Child's pillow case (child print)
66. Any sewn item not previously mentioned
67. Shorts and co-ordinating top
68. Cushion – patchwork & stuffed
69. Cushion – quilted & stuffed from panel

Sewing Champion:

The exhibitor receiving the most points in sections 49 to 69 in Quilts & Sewing will be declared Sewing Champion and will be invited to the Friday Night Show. Champion will be awarded \$50.

Winner is eligible once every 2 years.

Quilts:

Exhibitor must be an individual (not a group)

70. Quilt – hand appliqued – any size
71. Quilt – hand quilted/pieced – any size
72. Quilt – for child's crib (No hand tied quilts)
73. Quilt – machine quilted (cannot be crib quilt)
74. Quilted wall hanging- must having top casing/loops
75. Comforter – tied – any size
76. Any quilted item incorporating theme "Summer Fun Happens Here"
77. Lap quilt – any style
78. Quilt – using preprinted top and any method of quilting
79. Quilt – made from recycled blue jeans.
80. Recycled quilt – made from old clothing pieces
81. Any other quilted item not previously mentioned

First-place winners of either Hand- or Machine-made Quilts that meet the size requirements may be invited to submit their entry to the OAAS District level competition in November.
