1. Beets, table, $\frac{3}{4}$ " tops – 5
2. Beets, Cylinder, $\frac{3}{4}$ " tops – 5
3. Cabbage, white, 1 head
4. Cabbage, red, 1 head
5. Carrots, table, $\frac{1}{2}$ " tops – 5
6. String beans, green – 5
7. String beans, yellow – 5
8. Peas, any variety, properly named – 5
9. Radishes – 3
10. Peppers, green sweet, $\frac{1}{2}$ " stem – 2
11. Peppers, red, hot, $\frac{1}{2}$ " stem – 3
12. Peppers, green, hot, $\frac{1}{2}$ " stem – 3
13. Onions, cooking onions, $\frac{1}{2}$ " tops from bulbs, trim bottom root, no dirt – 5
14. Onions, Spanish, $\frac{1}{2}$ " tops from bulb, trim bottom root, no dirt – 5
15. Potatoes, white, not less than 2" in diameter, shallow eyed, uniform size, brushed clean – 5

16. Potatoes, coloured, not less than 2" in diameter, shallow eyed, uniform size, brushed clean – 5
17. Squash, any variety, properly named, extended flower stem, wiped clean - 2
18. Pumpkin, field, stems to be left on – 1
19. Herbs, 3 varieties in a small container of water, properly named
20. Tomatoes, red, not paste type, stems on - 3
21. Cherry tomatoes – 1 berry box (quart)
22. Cucumbers, slicing, 4-5" long - 3
23. Cucumbers, pickling, 2-3" long - 5
24. Zucchini, no longer than 8" - 2
25. Kale, leaf displayed in container of water - 2
26. Rhubarb, 10" long, trim leaves - 3
27. Any variety of vegetable not previously mentioned, properly named – 2
28. Ground cherries – 1 berry box
29. Raspberries – 1 berry box
